



# 30th Todmorden Boundary Walk

## Sunday 6th May 2012

The designated charities this year are the "The Motor Neurone Disease Association" and other charities supported by the Rotary Club of Todmorden.

There are TWO walks, the usual Todmorden Borough Boundary Walk using the same route as previous years and a shorter one called "The Pike Hike", both start at the Bellholme sports field (on the Todmorden-Rochdale Road). Limited Car Parking is available at Bellholme for a fee of £2-00/car.

The Boundary Walk covers approximately 22 miles in up to 10.5 hours, following the boundary of the old Borough of Todmorden. The Pike Hike (approximately 12 miles in up to 5 hours) is along the canal towpath to Eastwood then joins the last section of the Boundary Walk up to Stoodley Pike and back to Bellholme. Both are supervised with check points and radio control along their lengths to ensure your safety. Light refreshments will be issued at the registration and transport will be provided at check points to return those who do not wish to continue. Please mark on your entry form which walk you wish to enter.

The entry fee for The Boundary Walk is £10 per person, £7 for those under 16 years of age. Fees for the "Pike Hike" are £8 and £6 respectively. A surcharge of £2-00 per person will be applied for all entries received on the day of the event. Cheques for both walks should be made payable to: Boundary Walk

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### Conditions for all entrants on both walks

Your signature on the Entry Form will be deemed as acceptance of the following conditions, and any advice given on the day of the event by the Organisers and the Rescue Services, and that you agree that no liability is accepted by the Organisers for any injury, loss or damage sustained during the event.

1. NO DOGS are allowed on the Boundary Walk (Rescue dogs excepted) but DOGS ARE allowed on the "Pike Hike". Guide lines for looking after dogs will be posted clearly at registration and should be adhered to.
2. The minimum age limit is 10 years of age and Children aged 10 to 14 years must be accompanied by a parent/guardian in a maximum ratio one Parent /Guardian to two children.
3. Young people aged 15 to 18 years will only be allowed to walk by permission of their parent/guardian and a signature of the parent/guardian is required on the entry form.
4. Walkers should wear suitable clothing and footwear for the open moorland conditions which will be encountered and should consider carrying spare clothing.
5. Walkers should respect farm property and keep to the marked route which has been agreed with landowners.
6. Walkers should honour The Country Code by fastening farm gates, not lighting fires, leaving livestock, farm machinery and crops alone, take litter home and protecting wildlife, plants and trees.
7. Walkers who wish to drop out part way through the walk should do so at a Check Point and hand in their tab to an official at the Check Point so they can be accounted for.
8. Advice given by Walk Marshals and Rescue Services Personnel should be accepted.
9. Walkers enter at their own risk and they should make their own personal accident insurance arrangements.
10. The Organisers reserve the right to amend the route or cancel the event at short notice, eg if the weather poses an unacceptable risk. In such circumstances it is regretted that entry fees cannot be refunded.
11. Registration on the day is at Bellholme between 8.00 a.m. and 9.15 a.m for the Boundary Walk and 9.00am and 10.00am for the "Pike Hike".

Complete the Entry Form (one for each entrant) and return it with the entrance fee (including car park fee if required) together with a C5 stamped addressed envelope (160mmx230mm) for your receipt brochure, to N.S Caddy, 2 Fir Wood Close, Walsden, Todmorden, Lancs OL1 4 7QB. Be sure to indicate which walk you intend to do.

### Be sure to bring your receipt to registration on the day

The most suitable map(s) covering the area of the walk are either OS sheets SD82, SD91, & SD92 or OS map "South Pennines". Maps marked and showing the routes of each walk will be available on the day of the event at a price of £1-00 each
